### APPLICANT GUIDELINES

The applicant will be invited to participate in playing during the group rehearsal portion of the business meeting.

The process of becoming a member and the "Order of Business" (including date, time and place to meet with the ACC) will be explained.

The applicant will be presented with the club's tune list, sheet music and cassettes for learning aides.

The applicant will audition for the Audition Committee at a designated time.

On recommendation by the Audition Committee, a final audition will be arranged at a regular Fiddle Club business meeting.

At the final audition, the applicant will be asked to present a list of six tunes from the Club's repertoire of which the members will choose two tunes to be played.

After the final audition, the applicant will be asked to leave the room with his/her entourage while a determination is made.

When the membership has rendered a decision, the applicant and entourage will be asked to return to the room. The President/Delegate will relate the outcome of the decision to the applicant.

After Applicant becomes a member:

1. Annual dues will be paid to the treasurer.
2. Guidelines for Club Performances and Bylaws will be presented.
